





PEF-552 Health & Wellness for the Older Adult enrollment continues to increase with 774 students which is the largest enrollment for this course since the previous record of 735 (Fall 2023).

Visualization of Credit* and NonCredit WSCH *excluding RSP






Another view of Visualization of Credit* and NonCredit WSCH

Prior to Spring 2024, the peak credit spring term for LTCC was in 2019.

The noncredit spring pattern is a bit different in that with the addition of the PEF 552 course in 2019, the impact of COVID was mostly evident when face-to-face courses were not available (2020 and 2021)

Not only has the college recovered from the impact of COVID but is once again on an increasing enrollment trend.
